OVERVIEW

Crafted from selected vineyards in the Stellenbosch region, this Chenin Blanc reflects the maritime influence of False Bay and combines purity of fruit, freshness and elegance in a modern South African style. The wine displays vibrant fruit character, refreshing acidity and a refined mineral finish.

ORIGIN

Helderberg, Stellenbosch, South Africa. Maritime-influenced vineyards on granite and shale soils.

VINIFICATION

Cool stainless-steel fermentation with a small oak component. Aged on fine lees for added texture.

ANALYSIS

Alc. 13.5% | TA 5.5 g/L | pH 3.3 | Dry-off dry

TASTING NOTES

Quince, pear and citrus blossom lead to green apple, ripe peach and a subtle honeyed nuance. Bright acidity carries through to a precise, mineral-driven finish.

FOOD PAIRING

8–10 °C | Seafood, grilled fish, poultry, Asian cuisine and chèvre.
